



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR BScN PROGRAMME

- 1. Applicants must be at least 17 years old.
- 2. Applicants must have a minimum of five (5) subjects at CXC/CSEC level.
- 3. Mandatory subjects are Mathematics, English Language, Biology OR Human and Social Biology.
- 4. Applicants **MUST NOT** have more than two (2) subjects at level/grade 3.
- 5. CAPE subjects at level 1-4 are accepted.

Please note a subject passed at different levels or from different examination boards will be counted as ONE subject for matriculation purposes. For example, French passes at CSEC and or GCE and or CAPE, would be regarded as ONE subject.

BScN APPLICATION - REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Applicants to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BScN) programme are required to submit the following documents along with a processing fee of EC\$25.00 to the Division of Nursing Education, Largo Height.

- 1. **Certified copies** of the following:
 - Birth certificate
 - Academic certificates
 - Professional certificates
 - Marriage certificate or Deed Poll (whichever is applicable) if present name is different from that on documents
- 2. Two (2) passport-sized photos
 - Photos must be certified
- 3. Recent police record
- 4. Official transcripts from previous educational institutions
- 5. Two updated reference letters
- 6. A hand-written or typed letter stating why they are interested in applying for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.
