OR

Criteria 2:

- A Master's degree in the area of instruction or a closely related field;
- At least three (3) years of teaching experience at the tertiary level or other relevant professional experience.

Adjunct Lecturers should have:

- A Bachelor's degree in the area of instruction or a closely related field;
- Relevant experience working or lecturing in that field.
